## EMPIRE OF LIGHT

A love letter to cinema, set in an English seaside town in the early 1980s, *Empire of Light* is a powerful and poignant story about human connection and the magic of cinema from Academy Award winning director Sam Mendes (*1917*, *Skyfall*). Created with touching tenderness and compassion by writer-director Mendes, this drama features a stellar ensemble cast led by Academy Award winner Olivia Colman (*The Favourite*, *The Lost Daughter*), BAFTA winner Micheal Ward and Academy Award winner Colin Firth (*The King's Speech*).

Set in and around a beautiful old picture palace on the south coast of England, the love story between Hilary (Colman) and Stephen (Michael Ward) offers an impassioned ode to the people who come together under the glow of cinema, and to the life affirming tales they share. Oscar winning composers Trent Reznor and Atticus Ross score the film whilst master cinematographer (and fellow Oscar winner) Roger Deakins exquisitely photographs the inhabitants of this narrative. *Empire of Light* is 24 frames a second of pure movie magic that will remind you of the restorative power of cinema and storytelling.

## THE BANSHEES OF INISHERIN

2022 | 109 min | United Kingdom/Ireland | Drama | 18+

**B** **BRITISH**-Irish playwright Martin McDonagh returns to the big screen with new work *The Banshees of Inisherin* following the 2017 Oscar-winning *Three Billboards Outside Ebbing, Missouri*. The film also reunites McDonagh with fellow Irishmen Colin Farrell and Brendan Gleeson who starred in his critically acclaimed debut, *In Bruges*. Set on a remote island off the west coast of Ireland during the Irish civil war, the serpentine narrative follows lifelong friends Padraic (Farrell) and Colm (Gleeson), who find themselves at an impasse when Colm unexpectedly puts an end to their friendship. A stunned Padraic, aided by his sister Siobhan (Kerry Condon) and troubled young islander Dominic (Barry Keoghan), endeavours to repair the relationship, refusing to take no for an answer. Padraic's repeated efforts to rekindle their bromance only strengthen his former friend's resolve and when a desperate ultimatum is delivered, events swiftly escalate, with shocking consequences. With a powerhouse cast *The Banshees of Inisherin* revels in the tension of the unknown, delivering an experience served with the requisite acerbic wit from writer/director McDonagh as he explores the lengths we will go to when we lose a close friend.

## WHAT'S LOVE GOT TO DO WITH IT?

*A* pitch perfect ballad of emotions, this romantic comedy (from the makers of *Love Actually* and *Four Weddings and a Funeral*) follows a filmmaker who decides to document her best friend's journey toward arranged marriage. Moving between London and Lahore, this is a story of love, friendship, tradition and iconoclasm.

How do you find lasting love in today's world? For documentary-maker and dating app addict Zoe (Lily James, *Rebecca*, *Darkest Hour*), swiping right has only delivered an endless stream of Mr. Wrongs, to her eccentric mother Cath's (Emma Thompson, *Good Luck to You*, *Leo Grande*) dismay. For childhood friend and neighbour Kaz (Shazad Latif, *The Second Best Exotic Marigold Hotel*), the answer is to follow his parents' example and opt for an arranged (or "assisted") marriage to a bright and beautiful bride from Pakistan. As Zoe films his journey to marry a stranger, she begins to wonder if she might have something to learn from a profoundly different approach to finding love. Striking a touching balance between respect for cultural customs and belief in the power of romance, *What's Love Got to Do with It?* offers an impassioned take on the notion of love, romance and finding that special someone.

**T**HE directorial debut from British-Australian Frances O'Connor (*Mansfield Park*), *Emily* offers an atmospheric, incisive portrait of *Wuthering Heights* author Emily Brontë. Transporting cinemagoers to 19th Century England this tale of infinite creativity and desire offers a haunting drama of a young woman's formidable journey toward discovering her vocation. The second youngest Brontë sibling, Emily (played to perfection by *Sex Education*'s Emma Mackey) was only three years old when she lost her mother.

Haplessly seeking the love of her father, Emily's only ally is her brother, Branwell (Fionn Whitehead, *The Duke BFF21*), who empowers Emily to pursue her creative passions. As artistic discovery is fueled by romantic catastrophe, Mackey's Brontë navigates triumphs and tragedies to create a deeply engaging and profoundly moving story. As evidenced in Brontë's eternal work, we see a tale of female oppression under a demanding patriarchy, as *Emily* presents the myriad of obstacles between Brontë as she challenged the status quo which was rooted in sexism. A brilliant showcase of talent and Brontë's legacy.

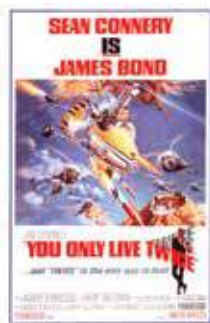

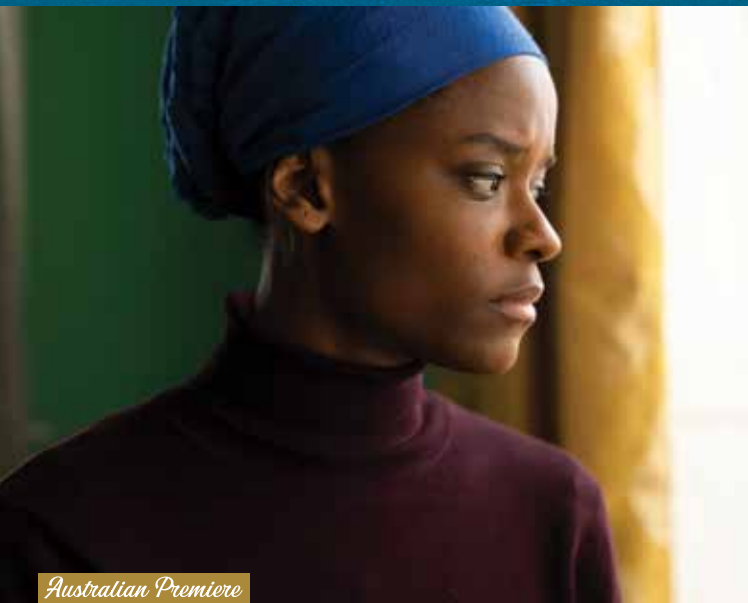

Designed to take the war to the enemy – and to win it – the Lancaster was both loved and feared. From the firestorms of Hamburg to the infamous Dambuster raids and the controversial bombing of Dresden, these emotional testimonies tell of courage, fear, friendship and moral ambiguity. Comprised of rare and newly re-mastered archival film from the Imperial War Museum and other sources, the heart of the film is the extraordinary recollections of the veterans who risked it all for the sake of history.
